Spell the lists of words in the year 5 and 6 curriculum.

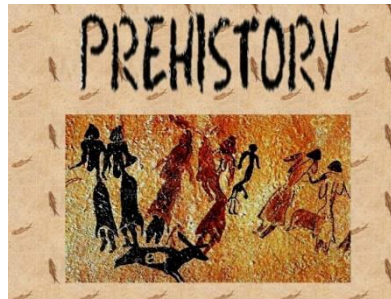


Questions we'll be asking...

In **Maths** we will be learning :

Mental calculation of all four operations.

The children will be learning:

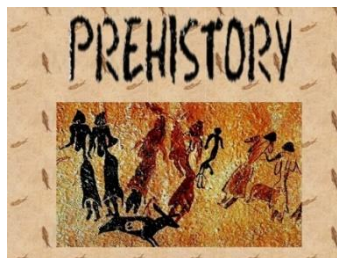
