

### In Literacy we will be learning to...

In Literacy this half term the children will be developing their speaking and listening skills through retelling stories with role-play and drama. In the 'Stories with Familiar Settings' unit the children will be learning about story structures, planning stories and writing their own stories. They will also be learning about non-fiction writing, including instructions and recounts. All children will have daily phonic sessions where they will learn, practise and apply their letters and sounds knowledge through reading and writing words.

Year 2 children will continue rehearsing and consolidating times table facts.
