In Maths we will be learning about :

- Improve our knowledge of multiplication and division facts.
- Create and interpret data using bar graphs, line graphs, frequency charts, Venn and Carroll Diagrams and pie charts.
- Improve our knowledge if time in both analogue and digit format.
- Use Roman numerals.
- Read scales for different measures
- Improve our fluency when using numbers.



In Science we will be learning to :

- Name and describe the different teeth we have and their functions.
- Understand how the digestive system works in our body.
- Learn which are the best foods for our bodies to stay healthy.
- Name some of the main bones in our body.
- Understand how bones, muscles and tendons work together.

In PE we will be learning to :

- Develop flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance [for example, through athletics and gymnastics]
- Develop their confidence and proficiency in swimming.
- Develop use of different strokes.
- Work towards being able to swim a distance of at least 25 metres and know how to stay safe near and in water.

In Computing we will be learning to:

- Improve our keyboard skills
- Develop our word processing skills.
- Edit our work to improve layout, grammar, spelling and punctuation
- Insert pictures into a word document.
- Understand how to communicate through email.

In PSHE we will be learning to:

- Understand the meaning of HONESTY and how easy or hard it can be.
- Appreciate the British value of Democracy.
- Evaluate the voting system in the UK including taking part in mock elections.
- Understand that relationships can be very different.
- Prepare ourselves for transition and the changes that will occur in our bodies and our future.



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In RE we will be learning:

- About The People of God
- We will discover how the Old Testament tells the story of the children of Israel and their relationship with God.
- Develop our understanding of Jewish beliefs, rites of passage, traditions and places of worship.

In Topic we will be learning to:

- Name and identify features and facts of the four countries within the United Kingdom.
- Follow the Romans on their path through Europe into the UK, looking particularly at St Albans and the legacy they left behind.
- Look at what it meant to be a Roman Soldier.
- Investigate the different Emperors and their impact on the Roman Empire.
- Understand why Hadrian's wall was built.
- Study the training that Roman soldiers took part in.
- Understand the impact of Roman technology, culture and beliefs.

In Music we will be learning to :

- Listen to the pattern, beat and rhythm of different music.
- March, in a synchronised manner, as Roman soldiers, to the varied beats.
- Use various instruments to create music to represent the different Roman Gods..

In French we will be learning to:

- Revise numbers, family, homes, food, colour, days of the week and months of the year and basic greetings.
- Tell the time
- Name parts of a town.
- Discuss holidays and hobbies.
- Appreciate French culture

In Art & DT we will be learning to:

- Explore Roman art and it's importance in history
- Use repeated pattern and shape to create Roman mosaics.
- Study Roman design, particularly viaducts and aqueducts.
- Design and build Roman armour e.g. shields and helmets
