- Recognize and write our names.
- Identify rhymes and alliteration.
- Be aware of story structures.
- Join in with stories, and recall settings, characters and events.
- Link sounds to letters, naming and sounding letters of the alphabet.
- Hear and say initial sounds in words.
- Orally segment and blend words.
- Give meaning to the marks we make, increasingly using clearly identifiable letters.

- What are your body parts called?
- What are your senses?
- Where do you live?

In Maths we will be learning to...

- Subitize numbers (recognise how many dots on a dice without counting)
- Recognise and create patterns
- Order objects and numbers
- Use number names and number language (0 - 10).
- Recognise numerals to 10.
- Identify one more and one less.
- Use positional language.
- Identify 2D shapes.
- Use 1p's to pay for fruit.
- Use time language including names of days, months and seasons.
